

Accreditation requirements – Generali Open Kitzbühel 2019

REGISTRATION

Registration deadline for the Generali Open Kitzbühel is **July 1st, 2019**. Late registration is only possible, after clearance by the organizers of the tournament, the KTC Turnier GmbH.

ACCREDITATION CONDITIONS

Prerequisites for a positive accreditation decision is the presentation of a valid press card. The coverage of the tournament before and during the event must be verified. In some cases, a confirmation of your employment relationship within your respective medium, signed by the editor in chief may be requested. The accreditation holder has the right to make, limitations and exceptions. The organizers of the Generali Open or its responsible representative are solely responsible for a positive accreditation.

SOUND, TV, FILM, PHOTO, RADIO, VIDEO RECORDING and MULTIMEDIA as well as the use of drones are subject to separate legal foundations.

No credentialed person may continually collect, disseminate, transmit, publish or release from the grounds of the Tournament any match scores or related statistical data during match play (from the commencement of a match through its conclusion for any commercial, betting or gambling purpose).

ACCREDITATION STATEMENT

The official badge for the Generali Open Kitzbühel grants access to the event site and the areas identified. The card is not transferable and must be shown unsolicited to enforcement authorities within the identified area. Their orders must be obeyed. The holder is subject to the conditions and regulations of the ATP tournament regulations, and the access system of the organizer. The number of reserved places for photographers at the respective tournament tennis courts are limited and subject to the approval of the organizing committee.

INTERNET / MULTIMEDIA

Media representatives from the Internet / multimedia area are subject to the same conditions as representatives of the "traditional" media (eg print, TV, etc). Photos and text about the event may be published on the Internet or other multi-media services (eg SMS, MMS, etc.) by the accredited media. Sound and moving pictures: The production, transfer and dissemination via the Internet and other multimedia services, whether live or delayed, in whole or in part, regardless of the device (mobile phone, MP3 player, digital camera, camera, notebook, etc.) and the technological process is not allowed. The ban on production of such content refers to all tournament tennis courts. Exemption only with the written approval of the OC.

BETTING BAN

All media areas at the Generali Open are gambling free zones. If any person credentialed for these areas found to be wagering on tennis or passing on insider information to third parties for the purpose of wagering, shall have their credentials revoked!

PENALTIES

Failure to comply with the accreditation rules or abuse of the badge will result in immediate withdrawal of the accreditation badge, lock on the next following tournament (accreditation) and in prosecution by the organizer.

PROTECTION OF DATA PRIVACY
